Orbiting around a 100-foot tower at 30 miles per hour, Vertigo offers thrill seekers a dizzy-licious ride

Amusement ride fanatics will love the newest ride at the 2011 Puyallup Fair – Vertigo.

The 100-foot tower ride can spin 24 riders at one time. Two riders each are strapped securely into 12 seats. Each seat dangles from a sturdy wire system, attached to one of 12 spires on a sphere.

After every seat is filled, the sphere orbits 100 feet in the air, twirling riders at a near heart-stopping 30 miles per hour. As riders swing around the tower, they can reach heights of 100 feet – or 10 stories – off the ground!

This ride is guaranteed to give any thrill seeker a ride they won't forget, plus an extra dose of dizziness. No wonder it is called Vertigo!
